



Eligibility and Registration

Eligible borrowers are public, private, and parochial school teachers in elementary, secondary, college/graduate, and adult education schools. Group child care centers, certified nursery schools, family child care providers, tutors, and approved home educators are also eligible. The school's location or the educator's residence must be in Carroll County.

Registration is annual, beginning on August 1. All cards expire on September 30 of the following year.

Carroll County Public Schools

- Faculty are automatically registered in the program.

Homeschool Educators

- Registration requires a valid certificate from CCPS or MSDE.

Family Child Care Providers and Certified Nursery Schools and Preschools

- Registration requires a valid certificate issued by the Maryland State Department of Education's Office of Child Care.

Private schools, group child care centers, and tutors must verify their eligibility by furnishing a written request on the organization's letterhead signed by principal, director, or librarian.

How to Access Your Account

A password enables you to access and view your Teachers Advantage Pass account online (catalog.carr.org) or by telephone (410-386-4456) at any time.

Passwords are registered in person at any library desk. You will be asked to choose your own password.

Using your username or the barcode on the back of the card and your password, you can:

- View a list of items you have borrowed
- See any fines or fees you owe
- View a list of items on hold
- Place holds on items

Benefits

- 3-week checkout
- 10-day grace period before fines are assessed
- Most CCPL materials may be renewed
- Booksale items at half-price

Selection of Materials

Materials must relate to work assignments. Teacher Advantage Pass loans are available only on materials owned by CCPL. Books, audio, and instructional DVDs are included. Because of their shorter loan period, feature films and items from the 7-Day collection are not included. Use of the Educator Loan card does not convey public performance rights for DVDs.

Fines and Fees

E-mail notifications are sent one day in advance of an item's due date. Educators receive a 10-day grace period from the due date before fines are charged; on the 11th day fines are charged retroactively. Renewals will not be permitted once fines and fees exceed \$10 or overdue items exceeds 20.

Replacement costs for lost or damaged material are the responsibility of the cardholder. If chronic problems of loss occur, Teacher Advantage Pass privileges may be revoked for the year. Revocation of borrowing privileges is at the discretion of the Librarian in Charge.
