(Unfold paper blank side out)

(Cut on line D)

I couldn't go outside and play.

(Unfold paper blank side out)

By Friday he was just a puddle;

(Cut line E)

A lumpy, slumpy melted muddle.

(Unfold paper blank side out)

Saturday the snow fell fast.

(Cut out tiny snowman)

I made a new man. Will he last?

(Turn around and unfold so child sees tiny snowman)
